



## Erasmus+ Mobility for Traineeship – SMP CALL 2018/2019

### What is?

Erasmus+ Mobility for Traineeship - SMP is the EU-promoted student mobility Programme which gives students a chance to broaden their vocational and training curriculum by working abroad in any public sector, company or a private commercial enterprise located in one of the European countries that have joined the Erasmus+ Programme. By doing a traineeship abroad with Erasmus+, you can improve not only your communication, language and inter-cultural skills, but also soft skills highly valued by future employers, as well as become more entrepreneurial.

### Who can participate?

In order to participate, you must be a regularly enrolled student, for the A.Y. 2017/2018, in one of the first, second or third cycle Degree Courses at UniMe. You can choose if carry out your traineeship before or after your graduation. Your traineeship must be relevant for your degree-related learning and personal development needs and, wherever possible, be integrated in your study programme ( so-called CURRICULAR Traineeship ). If you are an Non-EU student currently enrolled in UniMe and your mobility lasts **less than 3 months** (90 days), you can freely move within the Schengen Area (<https://www.schengenvisainfo.com/schengen-visa-countries-list/> ) with your Residence Permit valid for the entire period of mobility. For traineeships that last **more than 3 months (90 days)** you need to apply for the visa of the foreign country at the Diplomatic/Consular authorities of the host country located on the Italian soil. In any case, for traineeships in UK or Ireland, you always have to apply for a visa.

### Duration&Grants

Your Traineeship abroad can last from a **minimum of 2 months** to a **maximum of 12 months**. In any case, your period abroad must be spent not later than SEPTEMBER, 30th 2019. Every selected student will receive an Erasmus Scholarship, from a minimum of € 350.00 to a maximum of € 400.00 per month and **UniMe will pay grants for a total length of 4 months**. You can verify the exact amount of the grant provided per month for your destination Country by checking in the table below:

- to certificate your level of linguistic knowledge through the following way: International certification CEFR, linguistic test at CLAM, declaration in lieu of the language skills possessed;
- to agree with the Teacher responsible for International mobility in your Degree Course at UniMe your activities abroad, by filling in the **Learning agreement for Traineeship (LAT)**, that must be signed by him/her and uploaded in your Application.

**Important!** ONLY APPLICATIONS ACCOMPANIED BY THE LEARNING AGREEMENT FOR TRAINEESHIP WILL BE ACCEPTED, DULY COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY YOU, YOUR PROFESSOR AND THE TUTOR / MANAGER OF THE HOST INSTITUTION.
