Dr. Tindara Addabbo is Full Professor in Economic Policy at the Department of Economics Marco Biagi at University of Modena and Reggio Emilia (UNIMORE) where she coordinates the Ph.d. Programme in Labour, Development and Innovation. She is the UNIMORE Rector's Delegate for Equal Opportunities and president of the Italian Universities Equal Opportunities **Bodies** National Conference. She is member of CAPP (Centre for the Analysis of Public Policies), the Scientific Committee of Fondazione Marco Biagi and of the European Gender Budgeting Network, and the Coordinator of the ongoing EU project LeTSGEPs, coordinated by UNIMORE within the Horizon 2020 Research and Innovation Framework.



Dr. Ivana Suboticki is a researcher with the Department for Interdisciplinary Studies of Culture where she explores social inclusion and gender equality issues related to energy transitions and higher education reform. Her main research areas thus follow two distinct but interlinked fields of interest. First, she studies gender balance among university professors, with special focus on NTNU. The main interest is to explore how imbalances are produced in so-called epistemic living spaces where gender is formatted through the mediation of policies, strategies and practices. She has a PhD in Science and Technology Studies and has completed a Research Master in Social Sciences and a Bachelor in Anthropology from the University of Amsterdam, the Netherlands.

Dr. Angela O'Hagan is a Reader in equality, human rights, and public policy, Glasgow School for Business and Society, Glasgow Caledonian University. She is also Deputy Director of the WISE Centre for Economic Justice. Externally, Angela is Chair of the Scottish Government's Equality and Budgets Advisory Group, and other advisory groups on social security and economic recovery. She was a commissioner on the Commission on a Gender Equal Economy, and is a Trustee of the UK Women's Budget Group and the Scottish Women's Budget Group. She is a member of the European Gender Budgeting Network and co-editor with Elisabeth Klatzer of Gender Budgeting in Europe Developments and Challenges (2017).

Recent research projects include a 3-year evaluation of participatory budgeting in Scotland, advising the Welsh Government on gender budgeting through a project for the Wales Centre for Public Policy, and the ongoing #YourBudgetYourRights project with the Scottish Human Rights Commission. She is also a member of Gendersense, a Horizon 2020 project on gender budgeting led by the University of Iceland. She was a member of the Budget Review Group revising the Scottish Budget process in 2017 and the Commission on Local Tax Reform 2015-2016. Angela is a member of the newly formed SG Social Renewal Advisory Board, and a non-party member of the SNP Commission on Fairness and Social Justice.
