



NOTICE* Call Me Buddy

1. The University of Messina will proceed with the awarding of **24 Buddy tutoring grants**, drawing on the "long list" of capable and deserving students, containing the merit ranking referred to in 'Article 15 of the Framework Regulation relating to the collaborations provided by students to the University services and to peer tutoring, drawing on the resources of the "Fondo Sostegno Giovani Fund" referred to in the DM 1047/2017 art.3, year 2019';
2. Students interested in participating must meet the following requirements: to be included in the long list referred to in point 1; Possession of English language certification issued by an [Institution recognized by the MUR](#) (Ministry of Education, University and Research), level no less than B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference, or enrollment in an international study course or being enrolled / enrolled in a study course delivered in English;

For selection purposes, documented participation in international mobility programs promoted by UniME with a stay abroad for a period of not less than 2 months will also be taken into consideration as additional requirements.
3. The Call Me Buddy tutors will carry out a total activity of 25 hours, receiving € 10,00 per hour (including all tax and social security charges to be paid by the institution and assignee).
4. Buddy tutoring is coordinated by the administrative Department responsible for orientation and placement (COP) and the administrative department responsible for the management of services for international students, in collaboration with the Departments and Interdepartmental Structures of Connection.
