Curriculum vitae

Prof. Alessandra Tommasini, born in Messina (Me) on 10.28.1972, received her law degree on 08.07.1994 at the Faculty (now Department) of Law of the University of Messina with full marks. and praise, as well as with publication rights.

In 1994 she was the winner of a six-month scholarship, announced by the Bonino-Pulejo Foundation of Messina, on the research topic "The resolution of agrarian contracts for serious non-fulfillment", used at the Department of Common Law Assets (Prof. Raffaele Rossi) - University of Federico II of Naples.

In the month of September of the year 1997 she passed the exam for admission to the research doctorate, lasting three years, in "Private economics law" (Cycle XII), at the Faculty of Law of the University of Catania, obtaining the PhD degree on 11.06.2001.

On 21 October 1997 she obtained the qualification to practice as a lawyer with a total grade of three hundred and fifty-four / four hundred and fifty. As of 28.01.1998 to date it is registered in the Register of Lawyers of the Court of Messina.
