International Credit Mobility – KA107

A general overview

- ✓ Part of the Erasmus+ Programme
- ✓ Allows students to gain a study experience in a Non-European University
- ✓ Study period: min. 3 months – max. 24 months (only for students enrolled in a Single-cycle Degree Course)
- ✓ Two calls per year: fall and spring semester



International Credit Mobility – KA107

Student support

- **Scholarship** amount: 700 Euro/month
- **Travel contribution** based on the EC distance calculator:

Travel distances ³¹	Amount
Between 10 and 99 KM:	20 EUR per participant
Between 100 and 499 KM:	180 EUR per participant
Between 500 and 1999 KM:	275 EUR per participant
Between 2000 and 2999 KM:	360 EUR per participant
Between 3000 and 3999 KM:	530 EUR per participant
Between 4000 and 7999 KM:	820 EUR per participant
8000 KM or more:	1500 EUR per participant

Student around the world (SAW)

A general overview

- ✓ Allows UniME students to gain a study experience in an Extra-European University in the context of international cooperation agreements
- ✓ Study period: min. 3 months – max.6 months (if funds remaining, up to 12 months)
- ✓ One call per year: spring



Student around the world (SAW)

Student Support

✓ Scholarship amount: min. 350 €/month – max. 600 €/month according to the ISEEU certificate of income. The ISEEU is not mandatory but will determine the amount of your scholarship. In absence, your scholarship will be set at the minimum level.

Student's ISEEU certificate of income	Scholarship amount per month
$ISEE \leq €13.000$	€600
$13.000 < ISEE \leq 21.000$	€550
$21.000 < ISEE \leq 26.000$	€500
$26.000 < ISEE \leq 30.000$	€450
$ISEE > 30.000$	€350

✓ Travel contribution based on the EC distance calculator (no contribution is due if your ISEEU is major of € 30.000)

Documents

- ✓ Learning agreement for studies
- ✓ Document attesting linguistic competence
- ✓ ISEEU certificate of income, which can be asked to an authorised C.A.F. office. In order to obtain it, you need to bring the Family or Personal Income Statement that you received from the Italian Embassy to the C.A.F. office (only for international students)

The SISM organizes and manages a plenty of international mobility projects in partnership with the International Federation of Medical Students Associations (IFMSA)

- ✓ “Professional Exchange” and “Research Exchange”: allow students to carry out a traineeship in their field of interest or a research thesis period abroad
- ✓ Mobility take place between June and September or between December and February
- ✓ By virtue of an Agreement, UniME recognizes up to 4 ECTS for each of these activities
