**Interdisciplinary Post-graduate Study Programme
on EU Institutions, Law, Economics and Policies**

The **European College of Parma Foundation** is a postgraduate institute offering academic training for young graduates in the fields of **European Union law, economics, politics** and **policies**.

The training provided is geared to preparing students for careers in institutions, professional associations, the corporate world and private practice at European, national as well as local levels. Studying at the College means enhancing one's professional skills and learning to deal with European policies and to participate in their implementation.

The **Diploma and University Master in Advanced European Studies** (DAES) is a top-level interdisciplinary postgraduate study programme on European studies. Faculty includes top EU officials, professors and experts in European issues. The participation of students from different countries leads to the creation of an **international environment** where diverse cultures meet and build true opportunities of integration.

Study Programme

The study programme is divided into two phases.

Diploma in Advanced European Studies

The first phase includes two semesters (October to July). The training includes **lectures, lectiones magistrales, debates, workshops, research and group** activities, as well as **study visits** to Institutions and companies. Exams take place in January/February (1st semester) and June/July (2nd semester).

University Master in Advanced European Studies

Graduates in Advanced European Studies can obtain a **University Master's Degree** by writing a dissertation under the supervision of a College professor on a European issue within the scope of the DAES study programme.

Through specific agreements between the European College and three Italian Universities, DAES graduates can achieve University Master's Degrees with one of the following universities:

- **University of Parma;**
- **LUISS Guido Carli University, Rome;**
- **Suor Orsola Benincasa University, Naples.**

Working Languages

Lectures and training within the study programme are held in three languages: **English, French** and **Italian**. Most training activities are however held in English.

Preparatory **language training** is provided at the beginning of the course so as to enable students to boost their initial skills, and further develop them during the academic year.

Traineeships

The European College organises **traineeships** for its graduates within public offices, professional associations and companies at national levels as well as at European and international levels. Numerous graduates have succeeded in obtaining traineeships within the European institutions, in particular at the European Commission. Graduates also often report on successful experiences achieved in the labour market at European level. A significant number of graduates have also succeeded in **competitions run by European Institutions**.

Who can apply

The **Diploma and University Master in Advanced European Studies** is targeted to EU and non-EU **graduates** holding university degrees in **economic, legal, political, social** and **language** studies, as well as other related fields of study.

Deadlines for Submission of Applications:

- **19 June 2017** (first round of admissions)
- **15 July 2017** (second round of admissions)
- **28 August 2017** (third round of admissions)
- **20 September 2017** (final round of admissions).
