#### CONTEXT

Since last year the Law Department of University of Messina is a member of IASIA and it is signed a Memorandum of Understanding between University of Messina and IASIA.

The IASIA liaised the University of Messina with the Chinese Academy of Governance. During the 2016 Joint Congress IASIA-IISA in Chengdu, the University of Messina signed a framework cooperation agreement with the Chengdu Administration Institute.

In this framework of cooperation, a delegation of Chengdu Administration Institute will be at University of Messina from the 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rt</sup> of June to take part in an international high training course on 'Italian Administrative Law in global context'.

The Rector of Messina University, Prof. Pietro Navarra, will welcome the participants at the beginning of the meeting. Afterwards they will visit university and meet some municipalities.

During the course the IASIA Executive Secretariat will present the IASIA and its activities especially to promote our membership.

China and Italy are carrying forward a diversified programs and activities aimed to enhance mutual understanding and traditional friendship between the two peoples. Italy is a major EU country with worldwide influence and China stands ready to heighten communication and coordination with Italy on the reform of priority fields. # GENERAL THEME OF THE INTERNATIONAL HIGH TRAINING COURSE

The course will focus on the general theme of "Italian Administrative Law in global context".

### **GENERAL OBJECTIVE**

The general objective of this activity is to enable CIA participants to know the main issues facing Public Administration, both in the Italian and the China Administration, and the fundamental reforms experienced to redress them, both at central, regional and local levels.

### **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- Presentation of the main challenges facing decentralization in Italy and how Italy is working to redress them, mainly through training and capacity building;
- Presentation of the place of Public Administration in the dynamics of reform in Italy, at central, regional and local level;
- Visit to several Institutions contributing to the anchoring of good governance in Italy;
- Discovery different aspects of the Italian culture and history.

#### **DIDACTIC METHODS**

The International High Traning Course includes:

- Several Seminars animated by Academics, Lecturers, high-level Experts, Interpreters;
- Visits to the Institutions;
- Cultural and touristic visits.
