

This monograph contains a study of the category of the “Umma messenger texts”, the most abundant category of Neo-Sumerian tablets coming from the province of Umma. Here all the published and a few unpublished Umma messenger texts (in all, 2.028 tablets), subdivided into the 14 groups of R. McNeil’s dissertation, are collected and discussed, and besides all the officials mentioned in these texts, with the respective titles, are listed.
