Presentation and organization of the course

Registration from 14 March until June 15, 2022

Teaching

- 60 hours of lessons, covering written and spoken French, spread over 3 weeks with the possibility of registering for 1, 2 or 3 weeks.
- Reception of students and information meeting: July 4 at the Bordeaux Montaigne university at 9:30 a.m. for a welcome with coffee and 10:15 a.m. for the presentation of the course.
- Attribution of timetables and groups for students according to level of French (based on the online evaluation).
