Nei giorni 24-25 maggio 2021 la prof.ssa Caterina Malta, Coordinatrice del Dottorato di ricerca in Scienze umanistiche, ha consultato per via telematica il Collegio dei Docenti perché deliberasse sul seguente punto all'odg.

-approvazione della bozza definitiva della cotutela di Noemi Seminara (36° ciclo) con l'Università di Augsburg.

Nella convocazione la Coordinatrice ha ricordato al Collegio che il testo della bozza era stato approvato nella riunione del Collegio del 19 aprile 2021. Ha comunicato che l'Università di Augsburg ha finalmente licenziato (e firmato) l'Accordo con qualche lieve modifica rispetto alla versione già approvata: i punti interessati riguardano l'aggiornamento del periodo da trascorrere presso Unime, in conseguenza della situazione pandemica (art. 7) e la precisazione delle modalità di valutazione (art. 9). Gli uffici chiedono che la bozza allegata sia esitata con urgenza anche dal Collegio come versione definitiva.

La consultazione si è aperta il 24 maggio 2021 alle ore 20,15 e si è chiusa il 25 maggio 2021 alle ore 20.

## **Article 1 – Joint thesis supervision**

The partner institutions hereby agree that they shall assume joint responsibility for the supervision of the doctoral student's doctoral research project, the organisation of the doctoral examination and the award of a doctoral degree.

## **Article 2 – Supervision of the doctoral student**

The doctoral student shall be supervised by the following thesis advisors:

- At Unime (Host Institution):

• Position: **Professor** 

- At UniAugsburg (Home Institution):
  - Name: Sabine Schwarze
  - Department: Philologisch-Historische Fakultät
  - Position: **Professor**

The thesis advisors undertake to fully assume their responsibilities as the doctoral student's supervisors, which includes holding consultations when required so as to be able to assess the progress being made in the research project.

The PhD student should follow the official activities of the PhD program XXXVI Cycle during his staying at Messina as provided by the two Supervisors.

#### Article 3 – Admission to doctoral studies – Doctoral thesis subject

The doctoral student will be admitted at the first year of academic year 2020/2021 of the doctoral course in **Scienze umanistiche** XXXVI Ciclo. The doctoral program lasts three years and will end on October 31, 2023. At University of Augsburg the doctoral student is already registered at the first academic year 2020/2021 of the doctoral course in **Graduiertenschule für Geistes und Sozialwissenschaften Augsburg (GGS)**. The doctoral program last three years and will end until October 2023, third academic year.

#### Article 4 – Enrolment and student service fees

The enrolment fees will be paid only at University of Augsburg and the student will be exempted from the payment of fees at the UNIME.

## **Article 5 – Award of the degree**

If the doctoral student has passed the joint doctoral examination successfully, she shall be separately awarded

a joint degree by the partner institutions conferring the following degrees:

- Doktorin der Philosophie (Dr. phil.) in Romanische Sprachwissenschaft/Italienisch.
- Dottore di ricerca (PhD) in: Scienze Umanistiche (UNIME)

#### **Article 6 – Insurance cover**

The two institutions will guarantee Insurance coverage against physical injuries and third party liability whilst performing her duties within the framework of the doctoral research project at the two partner institutions. In addition to that, the doctoral student could take further steps in order to arrange health insurance in accordance with the national regulations in force.

## **Article 7 – Research at partner institution**

The doctoral student shall spend 18 months at UniAugsburg and 18 at UNME. The period of the joint research activities should be organized as follow:

Due to the COVID-2019 emergency, the possibility of varying the periods of stay in the two universities will be considered.

#### Article 8 – Admission at the final examination and thesis defence Committeee

According to Italian rules, to obtain the admission at the final examination, the thesis will be evaluated by two reviewers that are external professors that don't participate in the final examination. If the evaluation of the reviewers and of the Italian Board of professors is positive and they don't ask for modifications of the thesis, the final examination could be taken until January 2024. If the evaluation of the reviewers and the Italian Board of professors is positive, but they ask for modifications of the thesis, the final examination could be postponed until maximum six months. In this case the final examination will be taken from May 2024 until June 2024. The only Examination Board shall be comprised of six members (professors in the same scientific area) including the two thesis advisors that don't evaluate the candidate.

The two institutions, by means of the Deans, exchange any piece of information and all documents relevant to the organization of the joint sponsorship described in the present agreement.

### **Article 9 – Doctoral thesis defence (public discussion)**

The public defence of the doctoral thesis shall take place in Messina following the deadline provided by the partners law.

The Committee gives an overall assessment of the thesis and the doctoral student's career, choosing from the following evaluations: 'sufficiente', 'buono', 'ottimo'. The Committee may award an honourable mention (lode) if the scientific results are particularly significant. If the thesis is rejected, it will no longer be possible to discuss it.

#### **Article 10 – Language**

The doctoral thesis shall be written in **Italian** (**corpus**) An abstract of the doctoral thesis shall be supplied in **German** The PhD thesis defence shall be in **Italian** 

## **Article 11 – Intellectual property rights**

Intellectual property ownership will be based on the principle of inventor owns in accordance with the respective policies of each of the partner institutions.

Therefore the protection of the research results arising from the doctoral research project, as well as any matter related to filing them, making them accessible, their publication and exploitation shall be discussed and agreed by the partner institutions and be in accordance with the national and institutional regulations in force.

## **Article 12 – Commencement and validity of the Agreement**

The present agreement shall take as and from the date of its execution by the authorised representative of each contracting Institution and expires at the end of final examination procedure.

## Article 13 – Validity of the Agreement and settlements of disputes

The stipulations of this agreement may not conflict with the provisions of the regulations at of the two Institutions. Disputes must be resolved amicably through friendly bilateral consultations.
