## COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT between

## Jesuit University Ignatianum in Krakow, Poland

## And

## University of Messina, Italy

- 1. Jesuit University Ignatianum in Krakow, Poland and University of Messina, Italy hereby enter into an agreement of co-operation in teaching, research and development and areas of mutual academic interest related to higher education.
- 2. The two institutions enter into the agreement with the aim of developing a strong academic co-operation between the two institutions, which in turn will make possible the strengthening of the partnership between the two countries of Italy and Poland and facilitate a deeper understanding of their respective living and working conditions.
- 3. The two institutions agree, in principle, to co-operate over the full spectrum of their interest with specific agreements governing individual subject areas. This cooperation will be chiefly concerned with:
- A. Exchange of or hosting visiting academic, technical and administrative staff;
- B. Exchange of students on undergraduate and postgraduate programmes to secure practical experience;
- C. Registration of postgraduate students on joint research degree programmes;
- D. Establishment of direct data links and other electronic communication
- E. Publication of joint papers and technical communications on collaborative work;
- F. Organisation of conferences, seminars and workshops for dissemination of findings:
- G. Certification of study programme for recognition in the partner institution.
- 4. Each host institution will assist with locating accommodation for staff and students who are participating in exchange programmes or according to the agreement, but will not be financially responsible for any such accommodation.
- 5. The common discipline areas identified in the two institutions are, at present, in the areas of education, political sciences and linguistic studies and research. The Annexes to this agreement could detail the specific discipline-based collaborations agreed and the arrangements for monitoring them on an annual basis.
- 6. The arrangements for financing the collaboration will be the responsibility of each institution in their own country. This agreement represents no financial obligation of either institution to the other.
- 7. The agreement is for a period of five years from the date signed by both parties and may be terminated by either party, with or without a statement of the reasons for termination, shall be in writing and shall incorporate six months written notice to the



other party.
